Srivastava, Professor and Head of (Metallurgical Engineering), Dr. Srikant Prasad, (Professor and Head Electrical Engineering), Prof. Vinod Nagpure (Head of Civil Engineering). Minutes of last meeting were read, and they were confirmed.
2. With due permission of the Chair, Registrar shared a brief presentation based on the current achievements/activities, admission overview, approval of intake, admission notification for the session 2022-23 and award of degree to the passed-out students of the year 2021-22.
3. The members were intimated about the appointment of Ms. Shallu Jindal the Chancellor of the OP Jindal University after completion of the tenure of the then Chancellor Sri Praveen Purang, entry level scholarship distribution ceremony, recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff, research contribution by the faculty members, admissions statistics, awards and recognitions, various MoUs signed, placement, conferences and workshop, AIU chess championship, alumni meet, village adoption and other development work etc. All the members appreciated the activities carried out during last couple of months.
4. Member secretary presented the proposed intake for the year 2022-23 for the approval. He presented following variation in intake/ new courses, for the upcoming academic year:


- I. Looking towards the admission scenario of last couple of years in Civil Engg. Department, it was proposed to reduce the intake of B. Tech, Civil Engineering from 60 to 30.
- II. Starting of M. Tech in "Steel Technology" under department of Metallurgical Engineering and M. Tech in "Manufacturing Technology and Automation" under department of Mechanical Engineering with intake of 18 students in each.
- III. Starting of "Post Graduate Program in Management (EMBA)" for working executive under School of Management, with an intake of 30 students.
- IV. Starting of "B.Sc. (Hons.) in Biotechnology" with an intake of 60 students under School of Science, subjected to approval of
- V. Offering specialization of Energy Technology to 30 students of B. Tech Electrical Engineering.
- VI. There will be no changes in the other program/course in intake.

All the members unanimously approved the proposed intake for the session 2022-23. (Copy of intake is attached- Encl-1). However, Prof. Sanghi suggested that intake of all M. Tech program shall be kept 30 as it would occur any additional cost in terms of infrastructure and manpower. In this regard Hon'ble Vice Chancellor asked the Registrar to keep it in mind at the time of filling AICTE application.

5. The Registrar presented the list of 315 students of different program/courses, passed out in 2020-21 to whom degree to be awarded. It was approved unanimously.
6. Admission notification for the year 2022-23 was approved unanimously.
7. At the end of the meeting, the session was open for the members to contribute their valuable suggestions towards further improvement of the University. All the members were highly impressed in witnessing the flourishing growth of OPJU under the able guidance of the Vice-Chancellor and anticipated more achievements in near future.

The Vice Chancellor once again conveyed his sincere thanks to all the distinguished members for sparring their valuable time in attending the Academic Council Meeting.
